Patcharaporn Sumrit Nickname Cake, 8 years old, Grade 2 Primary School, Pornsila Alliance Church Association Bangkok

The church staff invited Cake to join their community activities. Cake needs to study additional subjects which she has failed to complete because of the COVID-19 situation. Studying online also meant she did not have time to be with her friends. When she came to have additional lessons in the church, Cake learned more. She likes studying Math with Teacher Tom, and English with Teacher Sai. Cake likes watching the Superbook story, "Job, A Man with Patience," because Job obeyed God and endured the trials that the devil brought, the pain, and the rebuke from his peers. Job continued praying to God. Because of this story, Cake decided to help her grandmother take care of her grandfather, who is bedridden. She helps change diapers, and, she also sweeps and mops their floor.

Life-Changing Stories through CBN's Mission

Grandma Nipa lost her job because of the pandemic, however, she has 6 grandchildren under her care. CBN provided start-up capital to help her setup a small business selling fried food in their neighborhood. Her grandchildren help her in selling too. They also learned more life skills in the church. Through The School of Life Project, they watched Superbook. They learned about God by watching the story of Job, and, have decided to become Christians.

They were fed and were taught how to read and write. They also learned other life skills from this project.

Because of this experience, she knew that - God really exists; God is love; and that, God loves her. Her family received miraculous help when she and her father got infected with COVID. Humanitarian Mission



From April 2022 to March 2023, Operation Blessing Foundation Thailand (OB Thailand) has been helping people in various difficult situations - from natural disasters, lack of job or earning opportunities, scarcity of clean water for consumption, or those in need of medical care to improve the quality of life in its various aspects through the following program and projects -

01 | Micro-enterprise for Families Program

With your generous donations, OB Thailand helps people in need and lack opportunities to work providing a source of sustainable income for their families in various communities. With this project, former inmates are also given an opportunity to start a new life. OB gives initial funding or capital, equipment, training on operations and management for a livelihood feasible for their conditions, and teaches them how to handle finances for their family security.

02 | Food Distribution Project

With your gifts of love, OB Thailand provides emergency food assistance for bereaved families during the first three months of losing the head of their family from an accident or long-term illness. This aims to help family members transition with their lives. The Food Distribution Project includes food distribution as Christmas blessing to 4 communities.

03 | Medical Brigade Project

Thank you for your unwavering commitment, OB Thailand has provided mobile medical services for 10 communities in 6 provinces, in the past year.

04 | Clean Water Project

Thanks to your generous support, OB Thailand was able to provide clean water for communities with shortage of water safe for daily consumption. OB assists in drilling groundwater wells and setting up water filtration systems. These communities were also taught proper hygiene and to drink clean water only. People from communities of Ban Huai Sai Khao, Chiang Rai Province and Ban Pa Kia Nok, Chiang Mai Province are now enjoying clean and safe water.

05 | Disaster Relief Project

Out of your cheerful giving, OB Thailand provided relief packs for flood victims of Typhoon Noru last October to November 2022 in 4 provinces: Ubon Ratchathani, Loei, Pathum Thani and Chachoengsao. Each relief pack has rice, dry food and various essentials.

SCHOOL OF LIFE

Because of your commitment, we are able to work with the local churches helping underprivileged children and children at risk in 11 communities in the provinces of Roi Et, Mukdahan, Nakhon Ratchasima, Ratchaburi, Pathum Thani, Chiang Rai and Bangkok. Activities for social, emotional, educational and moral values development were conducted for 2-3 days a week after school and on weekends, using Superbook lessons and supporting materials while also building relationships with families in the communities.

Udomchai Chahae (Ke), 19 years old, 6th Year, Senior High School at Pai Wittayakarn School





Udomchai participated in The School of Life in Pai since Grade 2 in primary school. He used to be the youngest child in the group, but now he is the oldest. Ke said, "The School of Life has taught me a lot. I was not confident to speak and to share what I think. But now, I am brave to make decisions and say what I think. Many of my friends from our village used to be with us too, but they have stopped coming. Now they are either addicts, alcoholics, have stopped studying, or are working in South Thailand. Some are in prison. In our group of 11 boys, only me and my friend, Chawaphon, finished Grade 6. I thank God The School of Life Project is there teaching me and has been helping mold my mind up to now. Next year, I will be studying in Chiang Mai. I have passed the exams for Chiangmai Technological College Automotive Division. I am a bit afraid because of the many things I must decide on, on my own, when I get there. New school, new friends, new society. But I am determined to find a church where I can worship God. Now, I have brought my 8-year old brother to The School of Life. I hope when he grows up, he will have a good life and will finish his studies like I did."

Ajan Boy, the administrator of The School of Life Project, said that Udomchai received Jesus at the age of 12. Ke is responsible, kind, honest, and he is helpful to others. Whenever there are activities here, he always helps. He plays bass guitar in the worship team. Though surrounded by family and relatives who are addicted to drugs, Ke never got himself involved with those things. He is a big help to his family, helping his mother plant garlic.

Thai Pang Mo Puang Church

Noy's grandchildren, Om and Nut, came to live with her and her husband, after their parents have abandoned them. Now, Ohm is 11 years old. Grandma Noy earns a living from picking vegetables in the fields, fishing, and finding other forest produce she can sell. While, Grandpa earns from mowing grass every now and then. They did not have regular earnings. Most of the time they only have chili paste to go with their rice during meals. When they joined the Keeping Families Project, they received a bag of relief goods. After a while, Grandpa passed away leaving all the burden of taking care of the grandchildren on Grandma alone. The Project stood by Grandma encouraging the whole family in their time of loss. She received 1,600 mushroom heads to start a mushroom farm, and a trike she can use for selling goods as well. While, Om was given a bicycle for going to school. Before, she had to walk for an hour to reach her school. Now, it only takes 15 minutes for her to travel! Grandma said,
